

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2023 OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL BUDGET AMENDMENT NO. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-062**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2                   **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3                   **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4                   **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5                   **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6                   **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7   **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Office of Attorney General's original budget in the amount of**  
8                   **\$3,469,729.00 was approved by Resolution No. 22-295; and**

9   **WHEREAS, the Office of Attorney General has prepared and submitted for review and**  
10                   **approval its FY 2023 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**  
11                   **reference and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and**

12   **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the**  
13                   **FY 2023 Office of Attorney General Budget by \$63,617.09, from \$3,469,729.00 to**  
14                   **\$3,533,346.09; and**

15   **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
16                   **2023 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its**  
17                   **approval.**

18   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
19                   **FY 2023 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1, which includes a**  
20                   **\$63,617.09 increase, from \$3,469,729.00 to \$3,533,346.09, that shall be funded by**  
21                   **the Nation's general fund.**

22   **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
23                   **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
24                   **expend the FY 2023 Office of Attorney General Budget as amended, provided that**  
25                   **any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**  
26                   **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27   **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15<sup>TH</sup>**  
28   **day of FEBRUARY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**  
29   **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
30   **Article VI Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
31   **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
32   **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
33   **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
