1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a federally recognized Indian tribe
2	,	organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,
3		1934 (48 Stat. 984; 25 U.S.C. § 476), which exercises sovereignty over both its
4		members and its lands; and
5	WHEREAS,	
6	WIREREAS,	pursuant to Article VI of the Nation's Constitution, the Tohono O'odham
7		Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is vested with all of the legislative
8		powers of the Nation and is empowered to enact laws, ordinances, and
9	WHEREAS,	resolutions necessary or incidental to the exercise of its legislative powers; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise (the "Gaming Enterprise") is a wholly
10		owned tribal governmental enterprise of the Nation established pursuant to
		Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Nation's Constitution and is responsible for
12		operating the Nation's gaming facilities and conducting gaming activities in
13		compliance with the requirements of the Gaming Ordinance (16 T.O.C. Chapter 1)
14		and the Charter of the Gaming Enterprise (the "Charter") (16 T.O.C. Chapter 2);
15		and
16	WHEREAS,	Section 5(d)(3) of the Charter charges the Gaming Enterprise with the
17		responsibility for planning, constructing, and management of all new or
18		additional gaming facilities; and
19	WHEREAS,	Section 5(d)(10) of the Charter authorizes the Management Board to enter into,
20		make, perform and carry out contracts for any lawful purpose pertaining to the
21		Enterprise's business; and
22	WHEREAS,	Section 8(b)(2) of the Charter provides for a limited waiver of the Gaming
23		Enterprise's sovereign immunity with respect to claims based upon a written
24		contract to which the Gaming Enterprise is a party; and
25	WHEREAS,	on May 19, 2022 the Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 22-187 which
26		approved a Tribal Land Assignment for the Far West Valley Area which authorized
27		the Gaming Enterprise to utilize 80 acres of the Nation's land located in Maricopa
28		County near the intersection of the Northern Parkway and Arizona State Route
29		303 (the "Far West Valley Area Land") for the purposes of developing a gaming
30		facility there once said land is taken into trust by the United States on behalf of
31		the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Far West Valley Casino"); and

1	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise is currently negotiating an agreement with Hunt-Penta VI,
2		a Joint Venture ("Hunt-Penta"), consisting of Hunt Construction Group, Inc., an
3		Indiana corporation, and Penta Building Group, LLC, a Nevada limited liability
4		company, for the purpose of engaging Hunt-Penta as its general contractor for
5		the construction of a new casino facility on the Far West Valley Area Land (the "Far
6		West Valley Area Casino Project Agreement"); and
7	WHEREAS,	Hunt-Penta has conditioned its acceptance of the terms of the Far West Valley
8		Area Casino Project Agreement upon the Nation approving a modification of the
9		Gaming Enterprise's limited waiver of immunity under Section 8(b)(2) of the
10		Enterprise's Charter, solely for the purposes of the Far West Valley Area Casino
11		Project Agreement and for the sole benefit of Hunt-Penta in the form attached
12		hereto as Exhibit A; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise Management Board recommends that the Legislative
14		Council approve this request to modify its limited waiver of sovereign immunity
15		in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A so that it may enter into the Far West
16		Valley Area Casino Project Agreement with Hunt-Penta for the construction of the
17		Far West Valley Casino; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the language of
19		the proposed waiver attached as Exhibit A and believes it is in the best interest of
20		the Nation to adopt a resolution that approves those modifications; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Nation's best interest will be served by modifying the Gaming Enterprise's
22		statutory waiver of sovereign immunity as provided in the attached Exhibit A.
23	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grants a
24		limited waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming
25		Enterprise in favor of Hunt-Penta for the purposes set forth in the Far West Valley
26		Area Casino Project Agreement and adopts the attached Exhibit A for that
27		purpose; provided that the Nation's sovereign immunity is not waived and
28		nothing in this Resolution shall be interpreted or construed as creating any
29		liability for the Nation with respect to any claims or other obligations asserted
30		against the Enterprise or arising out of or related to the Far West Valley Area
31		Casino Project Agreement.
