## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise Charter Amendment)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-070

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority to "authorize, charter and regulate public or private corporations
3		and associations" and to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,
4		morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its
5		members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(e) and 1(c)(2)); and
6	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 93-311, the Legislative Council approved the charter of the
7		Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority, subsequently renamed as the Tohono
8		O'odham Gaming Enterprise (the "Gaming Enterprise"), as a wholly owned tribal
9		government enterprise that is responsible for operating the Nation's gaming
10		facilities and conducting gaming activities (Charter of the Gaming Enterprise, as
11		amended, 16 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 2) ("Gaming Enterprise's Charter");
12		and
13	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 21-437, the Legislative Council, in pertinent part, amended
14		Section 6(m)(1) of the Gaming Enterprise's Charter to establish a first preference
15		for enrolled members of the Tohono O'odham Nation in all hiring, promotion,
16		training, lay-offs, and all other aspects of employment; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee recommends amending Section 6(m)(1) to clarify that
18		the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Office, consistent with its broad grant of civil
19		oversight authority over the Gaming Enterprise and the Nation's Constitution Art.
20		VII § (2)(c), is responsible for overseeing the Gaming Enterprise's implementation
21		and application of the "preference" mandate set forth at Section 6(m)(1) of the
22		Gaming Enterprise's Charter; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee recommends approving the above referenced
24		amendment to Section 6(m)(1) of the Gaming Enterprise's Charter which is
25		attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
26	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
27		proposed amendment to Section 6(m)(1) of the Gaming Enterprise's Charter.
