

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Health and Human Services Office for Victims
of Crime Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-085

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d) (2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and received from the U.S. Department
8 of Justice Office for Victims of Crime Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program, a
9 grant award in the amount of \$918,594.00 for the period of October 1, 2022 to
10 September 30, 2025; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for
12 review and approval its FY 2023 Office for Victims of Crime Tribal Victim Services
13 Set-Aside Program Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the
14 amount of \$918,594.00 to be funded by the Nation's general fund pending
15 reimbursement from the U.S. Department of Justice; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
17 reviewed the FY 2023 Department of Health and Human Services Office for
18 Victims of Crime Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget and
19 recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21 **FY 2023 Department of Health and Human Services Office for Victims of Crime**
22 **Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget, effective October 1, 2022**
23 **through September 30, 2025, in the amount of \$918,594.00 which shall be funded**
24 **by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the U.S. Department**
25 **of Justice.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
27 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
28 expend these funds for the period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2025,
29 and the Accounting Department is authorized to post the unexpended balance of
30 the budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted
31 for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


