

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Tohono O'odham Nation's FY 2024 San Miguel (Subdivision Road) BIA
Route 192 Project Community Project Funding Request)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-093

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2 the authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3 education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
4 and to "consult with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal
5 agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation and
6 all federal appropriation estimates and projects for the benefit of the Tohono
7 O'odham Nation . . ." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and

8 **WHEREAS,** on March 15, 2021, the United States House of Representatives announced the
9 return of federal earmark requests, now called Community Project Funding
10 Requests in the U.S. House of Representatives and Congressional Directed
11 Spending Requests in the U.S. Senate; and

12 **WHEREAS,** a certain segment of San Miguel (Subdivision Road), BIA Route 192, is in need of
13 grading, draining, and paving the existing unimproved earthen road, which
14 would improve and provide access to approximately 25 households on a school
15 bus route; and

16 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 22-208, the Legislative Council approved the addition of the San
17 Miguel (Subdivision Road), BIA Route 192 Project on the Nation's Tribal
18 Transportation Improvement Plan; and

19 **WHEREAS,** Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. and the Agricultural and Natural Resources and
20 Appropriations Committees reviewed the Nation's FY 2024 San Miguel
21 (Subdivision Road), BIA Route 192 Project Community Project Funding Request
22 and recommend support.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the
24 Nation's FY 2024 San Miguel (Subdivision Road), BIA Route 192 Project
25 Community Project Funding Request for submission to the Nation's federal
26 delegation.

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH**
28 **day of MARCH, 2023** at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT,** pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,
30 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
31 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
