

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY23 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget Amendments No.1)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-108

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget in the amount
8 of \$861,386.00 was approved by Resolution No. 21-183; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Arizona Department of Economic Security Workforce Innovation and
10 Opportunity Act ("WIOA") Title 1B, Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") was
11 approved by Resolution No. 21-343 and subsequently amended by Resolution 22-
12 396; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Arizona Department of Economic Security has extended the deadline for the
14 Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Education One Stop Division to expend
15 the funds until June 30, 2023; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Education has prepared and submitted for review and
17 approval its FY 2023 One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget Amendments No. 1, which is
18 incorporated by this reference, in the total amount of \$680,774.00 as follows:

- 19 1. PY21 Dislocated Worker, which includes a \$5,444.00 decrease from \$22,687.00
20 to \$17,243.00;
- 21 2. FY22 Dislocated Worker, which includes a \$28,181.00 decrease from
22 \$101,550.00 to \$73,369.00;
- 23 3. PY21 Youth Adult Admin, which includes a \$1,833.00 decrease from
24 \$9,526.00 to \$7,693.00;
- 25 4. PY21 Youth, which includes a \$72,870.00 decrease from \$370,108.00 to
26 \$297,238.00;
- 27 5. FY22 Adult Admin, which includes a \$1,363.00 decrease from \$6,498.00 to
28 \$5,135.00;
- 29 6. PY21 Adult, which includes a \$9,574.00 decrease from \$58,602.00 to
30 \$49,028.00;
- 31 7. FY22 Adult, which includes a \$61,347.00 decrease from \$292,415.00 to
32 \$231,068.00, which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and
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1 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget Amendments
2 **No. 1 will decrease the overall total FY 2023 One Stop PY21/FY22 Budgets by**
3 **\$180,612.00 from \$861,386.00 to \$680,774.00 for the period beginning on July 1,**
4 **2021 through June 30, 2023; and**

5 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
6 **reviewed the FY 2023 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget to**
7 **extend it through June 30, 2023; and**

8 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
9 **reviewed the FY 2023 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget**
10 **Amendments No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 12 **1. Amends the FY 2023 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budgets to**
13 **extend the effective dates from July 1, 2021 ending June 30, 2023, which will be**
14 **funded by the Arizona Department of Economic Security Workforce**
15 **Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA") Title 1B, Intergovernmental**
16 **Agreement ("IGA").**
- 17 **2. Approves the FY 2023 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budget**
18 **Amendments No. 1 effective July 1, 2021, which includes a total decrease of**
19 **\$180,612.00 from \$861,386.00 to \$680,774.00.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
22 **expend the FY 2023 Department of Education One Stop PY21/FY22 Budgets as**
23 **amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted**
24 **for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH**
26 **day of APRIL, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
