

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care Budget Amendments)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-112

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care Budgets in the amount of**
8 **\$139,276,667.96 was approved by Resolution No. 22-296; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care ("TONHC") has prepared and submitted**
10 **for review and approval the following FY 2023 Tohono O'odham Nation Health**
11 **Care Budget Amendments, as detailed in the Table as dated for reference January**
12 **2023, which is incorporated by this reference, and which identifies the budget**
13 **amendments and amended totals:**

21 **and recommend approval.**


22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**

28 **provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior**
29 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH day of APRIL, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


