14		current BIA contracts awarded in 2010, 2011, 2012, 2015, and 2020 that are in
15		various stages of design and/or construction, along with 19 road projects; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
17		has prepared and presented an amendment to the Tohono O'odham Nation 2022
18		– 2026 Roads Tribal Priority List (TPL) to modify estimated project cost amounts
19	!	as reflected in Exhibit A, Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Transportation
20		Improvement Plan, which is incorporated by this reference; and
21	WHEREAS,	Resolution No. 22-208, Resolution No. 22-155, Resolution No. 21-214, and
22		Resolution No. 21-051, which previously added public road improvement
23		projects to the Nation's TPL, shall be amended for FY 2023 - 2026 and shall remove
