5		O'odham Council" and "[t]o exercise the inherent powers of the Tohono O'odham
6		Nation by providing resolutions to promote, protect and provide for public
7		health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham
8		Nation and its members" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
9		Sections 1(c)(2) and (f)); and
10	WHEREAS,	Pima County may contract for services and enter into agreements with Indian
11		tribes for joint or cooperative action pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952 et seq.; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is committed to its partnership with Pima County
13		and the State of Arizona to coordinate the prompt processing, execution, and
14		enforcement of the laws of the State of Arizona and the Tohono O'odham Nation,
15		in a cooperative approach to law enforcement to enhance public safety to protect
16		all persons and property within the lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation and
17		Pima County through the appointment of prosecutors in the Tohono O'odham
18		Nation's Prosecutor's Office as Special Deputy County Attorneys in the Pima
19		County Attorney's Office; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Intergovernmental Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
21		Pima County ("Intergovernmental Agreement") will facilitate a cooperative
22		approach to law enforcement to enhance public safety to protect all persons and
23		property within the lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation and Pima County; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation's Prosecutor's Office desires to enter into the
25		Intergovernmental Agreement in order to coordinate the prompt processing,
26		execution, and enforcement of the State of Arizona or the Nation's warrants,
27		demands for extradition, and protection orders, and to authorize the
28		appointment of the Tohono O'odham Nation's prosecutors as Special Deputy
29		County Attorneys; and
30	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Intergovernmental Agreement
31		and recommends its approval; and
