LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Amending Election Contest Hearing Procedures)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 23-154

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation provides that the "Council shall
2		enact an election ordinance which shall prescribe the qualifications of
3		candidates, the registration requirements for voting and such other rules and
4		procedures necessary to the orderly conduct of elections, including but not
5		limited to procedures for validation of petitions and the settlement of any and all
6		election disputes." (Constitution, Article X, Section 7); and
7	WHEREAS,	the "decision of the Tohono O'odham Council in all election matters, including
8		the eligibility and qualifications of candidates, shall be final." (Constitution,
9		Article X, Section 7); and
10	WHEREAS,	12 T.O.C. Chapter 1 - Elections establishes the procedure for "any eligible voter of
11		the Nation" to contest an election upon specific grounds, including "for
12		misconduct on the part of any district election board or of the Board, or any
13		member thereof' (Elections, Section 1901(A)); and
14	WHEREAS,	when a contest statement alleges Board misconduct, the Legislative Council has
15		jurisdiction to hear the contest (Elections, Section 1904); and
16	WHEREAS,	in accordance with the Council's constitutional authority to "establish rules and
17		procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council" the
18		Legislative Council adopted amended Election Contest Hearing Procedures to
19		govern contests to the Nation's 2015 general election (Constitution, Article VI,
20		Section 1(a); Legislative Order No. 15-130); and
21	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Rules Committee recommends that the Council update the
22		Procedures by adopting the "Election Contest Hearing Procedures May 2023
23		Amendments," which are incorporated by this reference.
24	NOW, THERE	EFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it adopts
25		the Election Contest Hearing Procedures May 2023 Amendments; provided that
26		no other business shall be conducted during election contest hearings, which
27		shall be open to the public and shall be broadcast on the Nation's radio station.
