

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets Under the Public
Law 93-638 Master Contract)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-158

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Executive Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY
8 2024 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public Law 93-638 Master
9 Contract, which budgets are incorporated by this reference, in the amount of
10 \$18,497,991.39 to be funded by the Nation's resources pending reimbursement
11 from the grantor; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the following base budgets in the amount of \$16,306,533.48 have been prepared
13 as follows:

27 programs and the Budget and Finance Committee have reviewed the FY 2024
28 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public Law 93-638 Master Contracts
29 and recommend their approval.

30 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 31 **1. Approves the FY 2024 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public**
32 **Law 93-638 Master Contract effective October 1, 2023 in the amount of**
33 **\$18,497,991.39, which shall be funded by the Nation's resources pending**

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1 reimbursement from the grantor, subject to negotiation and execution of
2 annual funding agreements with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

3 2. Directs that in the event of a federal Continuing Resolution, the programs
4 shall limit spending to only essential program services, functions, and
5 activities; and the Nation shall seek reimbursement of all funds the Nation
6 expends for continuation of Bureau of Indian Affairs Programs performed
7 pursuant to the Master Contract.

8 3. Authorizes the Nation's chairperson or any delegated official to negotiate
9 and execute the FY 2024 Annual Funding Agreement with the Bureau of
10 Indian Affairs.

11 4. Authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated
12 official to administer and expend the FY 2024 Bureau of Indian Affairs
13 Budgets, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be
14 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD
16 day of MAY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,947.3 FOR;-0-
17 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 270.7[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
18 by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
19 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
20 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
21 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
