9		Revenue Funding Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount
10		of \$801,136.50 of which \$504,781.48 to be funded from the Nation's General Fund;
11		and \$296,355.02 is to be funded from TERO Commission fee revenue funding; and
12	WHEREAS,	the portion of the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Budget funded by the
13		Nation's general fund is addressed by separate resolution; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
15		reviewed the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees
16		Revenue Funding Budget and recommend its approval.
17	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18		FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees Revenue Funding
19		Budget effective October 1, 2023 in the amount of \$296,355.02, which shall be
20		funded from the TERO Commission fees revenue funding.
