

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights
Office Commission Fees Revenue Funding Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-177

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation... and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2024 Tribal Employment Rights Office ("TERO") Commission Fees
9 Revenue Funding Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount
10 of \$801,136.50 of which \$504,781.48 to be funded from the Nation's General Fund;
11 and \$296,355.02 is to be funded from TERO Commission fee revenue funding; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the portion of the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Budget funded by the
13 Nation's general fund is addressed by separate resolution; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
15 reviewed the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees
16 Revenue Funding Budget and recommend its approval.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18 FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees Revenue Funding
19 Budget effective October 1, 2023 in the amount of \$296,355.02, which shall be
20 funded from the TERO Commission fees revenue funding.

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
22 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
23 expend the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees Revenue
24 Funding Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be
25 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH**
27 **day of MAY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,947.3 FOR;**
28 **~~-0-~~ AGAINST; ~~-0-~~ NOT VOTING; and 270.7 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
29 **Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
30 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
31 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
32 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
