

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Legislative Branch Budget Amendment No. 2)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-201

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Legislative Branch Budget in the amount of \$5,228,360.04 was**
8 **approved by Resolution No. 22-297 and subsequently amended by Resolution No.**
9 **23-091; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY**
11 **2023 Legislative Branch Budget Amendment No. 2, which is incorporated by this**
12 **reference and which will adjust personnel and operational line items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Legislative Branch Budget Amendment No. 2 will not change the total**
14 **budget amount of \$5,228,360.04; and**


15 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2023 Legislative Branch**
16 **Budget Amendment No. 2 and recommends its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **FY 2023 Legislative Branch Budget Amendment No. 2, which will not change the**
19 **total budget amount of \$5,228,360.04, effective October 1, 2022; provided that the**
20 **amendment to line item 6000 will automatically be repealed upon the seating of**
21 **the Legislative Council officers after the 2023 general election.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Legislative Council chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**
24 **administer and expend the FY 2023 Legislative Branch Budget as amended,**
25 **provided that any modifications shall be submitted to the Budget and Finance**
26 **Committee for approval on behalf of the Legislative Council and amendments**
27 **shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**


28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25TH**
29 **day of MAY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,947.3 FOR;**
30 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 270.7 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
31 **Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
32 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
33 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
34 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


