

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental**  
**Agreement Amendment Nos. 4 and 5 between the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
**and the Arizona Department of Economic Security)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-202**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with  
2 the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on  
3 behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments  
4 and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions,  
5 or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the  
6 Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") is a federally  
8 funded program, administered through the Arizona Department of Economic  
9 Security ("ADES"), that helps low-income households pay their heating/cooling  
10 bills, minimize crises, and make energy costs more affordable; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the LIHEAP Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") between the Nation and ADES  
12 was approved by Resolution No. 20-234 for the period of July 1, 2020 through June  
13 30, 2025 which will provide funding to the Nation for the LIHEAP on an annual  
14 basis; and

15 **WHEREAS,** Amendment No. 1 was approved by Resolution No. 21-351, which revised the Case  
16 Management Service Budget in the amount of \$125,000.00 for the period of July 1,  
17 2021 through June 30, 2022; and

18 **WHEREAS,** Amendment No. 2 was approved by Resolution No. 22-021, which increased the  
19 Case Management Service Budget from \$125,000.00 to \$197,000.00 for the period  
20 of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, a total increase of \$72,000.00; and

21 **WHEREAS,** Amendment No. 3 was approved by Resolution No. 22-362, which provided the  
22 original Case Management Service Budget for the period of July 1, 2021 through  
23 June 30, 2022; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the ADES has submitted LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 4, which will revise the  
25 Itemized Service Budget for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; and

26 **WHEREAS,** in accordance with the Alert issued on September 7, 2022 the revised allocations  
27 are as follows: The total value of the budget is \$184,170.00 as detailed in the  
28 attached itemized service budget. This amount includes carryover funding from  
29 State Fiscal Year 2022 in the amount of \$27,920.00; and

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1 WHEREAS, the ADES has submitted LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 5, which will revise the  
2 Itemized Service Budget for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; and

3 WHEREAS, in accordance with the Alert issued on February 15, 2023, the revised allocations  
4 are as follows: The total value of the budget is \$274,588.00 as detailed in the  
5 attached itemized service budget; and

6 WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the LIHEAP IGA  
7 Amendment Nos. 4 and 5 and recommend its approval.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
9 LIHEAP IGA Amendment Nos. 4 and 5, and authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation  
10 chairperson to execute the LIHEAP IGA Amendment Nos. 4 and 5 in substantially  
11 the form attached, provided that any further amendments or modifications shall  
12 be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25<sup>TH</sup>  
14 day of MAY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,947.3 FOR;  
15 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 270.7[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
16 Council by, Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
17 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
19 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
