

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection
Office Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)-Tribal Response Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-211

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2023 Environmental Protection Office Bipartisan Infrastructure
9 Law-Tribal Response Program Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in
10 the amount of \$100,000.00 to be funded by the Nation's general fund pending
11 reimbursement from the grantor; U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, under
12 the (BIL)-Tribal Response Program Grant; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
14 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office Bipartisan
15 Infrastructure Law-Tribal Response Program Budget and recommend its
16 approval.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18 FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office Bipartisan
19 Infrastructure Law-Tribal Response Program Budget effective October 1, 2022 in
20 the amount of \$100,000.00, which shall be funded by Nation's general fund
21 pending reimbursement from the grantor, U.S. Environmental Protection
22 Agency, under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law-Tribal Response Program
23 Grant.

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
25 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
26 expend the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office
27 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law-Tribal Response Program Budget, provided that
28 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
29 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
