

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Fire Department Budget  
Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-244**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Fire Department Budget in the amount**  
8 **of \$6,175,273.55 was approved by Resolution No. 22-295; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**  
10 **approval its FY 2023 Fire Department Budget Amendment No. 1, which is**  
11 **incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational line items; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Fire Department Budget Amendment No.**  
13 **1 will not change the budget amount; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
15 **2023 Department of Public Safety Fire Department Budget Amendment No. 1 and**  
16 **recommend its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
18 **FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Fire Department Budget Amendment No. 1**  
19 **effective October 1, 2022, which will not change the overall budget amount of**  
20 **\$6,175,273.55 and which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
22 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
23 **expend the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Fire Department Budget as**  
24 **amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted**  
25 **for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup>**  
27 **day of JULY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**  
28 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
29 **Article IV, Sections 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
30 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
