4	WHEREAS	by Tohono O'odham Legislative Resolution No. 14-560, the Legislative Council
5		reserved accounts identified in the Economic Development Reserve Schedule to
6		meet the Nation's obligations under the then Non-Impairment Agreement
7		approved in December 2014 and in connection with a loan agreement between
8		the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise and the Bank of America, N.A.
9		("December 2014 Non-Impairment Agreement"; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Investment Committee determined that the Economic
11		Development Reserve is no longer needed under the December 2014 Non-
12		Impairment Agreement; and
13	WHEREAS	in accordance with Tohono O'odham Legislative Resolution No. 14-560 resolved
14		clause No. 6, the Tohono O'odham Investment Committee recommends it be
15		released from reserve; and
16	WHEREAS	the Tohono O'odham Investment Committee further recommends that Proceeds
17		of Labor account ending 9706 and the income-portion of Judgment account
18		ending 6215 at the United States Department of Interior's Bureau of Trust Fund
19		Administration be drawn down.
20	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends the
21		Economic Development Reserve established by Tohono O'odham Legislative
22		Resolution No. 14-560 and approves release of the accounts identified in the
23		Economic Development Reserve Schedule.
24	BE IT FURTE	IER RESOLVED that the Investment Committee will develop a plan for the use of the
25		released accounts from the reserve and will present the plan to the Legislative
26		Council for approval.
27	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the designee of the
28		Investment Committee of the Nation is authorized to draw down the Proceeds of
29		Labor account ending 9706 and the income-portion of Judgment account ending
30		6215 from the United States Department of Interior's Bureau of Trust Fund
