9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a Mutual Protection Agreement
10		approved by Resolution No. 20-016 which has expired; and
11	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated a new Law Enforcement Mutual Aid
12		Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the City of Glendale to
13		provide mutual aid and assistance in the field of law enforcement; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid
15		Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the City of Glendale and
16		recommends its approval.
17	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18		Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation
19		and the City of Glendale.
20	BE IT FINALL	Y RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
21		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the Law
22		Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and

24		amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
