

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-271

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program in the amount**
8 **of \$4,498,433.82 was approved by Resolution No. 22-266; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
10 **approval its FY 2023 Corrections Program Budget Amendment No. 1, which is**
11 **incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or**
12 **personnel line items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget**
14 **Amendment No.1 will increase by \$989,926.88 from \$4,498,433.82 to**
15 **\$5,488,360.70; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
17 **2023 Department of Public Safety Corrections Program Amendment No. 1 and**
18 **recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2023 Department of Public Safety Corrections Program Amendment No. 1**
21 **effective October 1, 2023, which includes an increase of \$989,926.88 from**
22 **\$4,498,433.82 to \$5,488,360.70 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund**
23 **pending reimbursement from the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
26 **expend the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget**
27 **as amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted**
28 **for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH**
30 **day of JULY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
31 **~~0~~ AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
32 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
33 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
34 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
35 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
