

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Gomez del Campo & Moreno LLP Attorney Contract)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-295

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2 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Legislative Council with the**
3 **power to "employ legal counsel for the protection and advancement of the rights**
4 **of the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
5 **Article VI, Section 2(a)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, it is a priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation to purchase historically O'odham**
7 **land in Mexico (Wo'oshan); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee and the Vice-Chairwoman of**
9 **the Nation, with the assistance of the Attorney General have identified Gomez del**
10 **Campo & Moreno LLP (the "Firm"), with offices in Arizona and Mexico, as**
11 **apparently able and willing to finalize whatever steps are necessary to conclude**
12 **the purchase of land in Mexico, while working with and overseeing other counsel**
13 **for the Nation in Mexico; and**

14 **WHEREAS, fees for services provided under this Contract, if any such services are provided**
15 **in FY 2023, will be paid out of the existing Attorney General's Professional Services**
16 **line item – the Office of Attorney General will be submitting a budget amendment**
17 **for FY 2024 to ensure that services provided under this attorney contract can**
18 **continue; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Agriculture and Natural Resources and the Domestic Affairs Committees have**
20 **reviewed the attorney contract with the Firm and recommend approval (the**
21 **Gomez del Campo & Moreno LLP Contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and**
22 **incorporated herein by this reference).**


23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
24 **attorney contract with Gomez del Campo & Moreno LLP, which contract will be**
25 **administered by the Office of Attorney General.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Nation Chairperson to execute the contract with Gomez del Campo &**
28 **Moreno LLP in substantially the form attached.**


29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
30 **day of AUGUST 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
31 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
32 **Article VI, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
33 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
34 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
35 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




