9		Planned Social Services Title XX Block Grant pursuant to Resolution No. 19-250,
10		ADES Contract number DI 20-002237; and
11	WHEREAS,	Amendment No. 1 was approved by Resolution No. 20-236, Amendment No. 2 was
12		approved by Resolution No. 21-134, Amendment No. 3 was approved by Resolution
13		No. 22-374, and Amendment No. 4 extends the IGA from July 1, 2023 to June 30,
14		2024; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Department of Education has submitted for review and approval Amendment
16		No. 4 to the IGA, which is incorporated by this reference, for the period of July 1,
17		2023 through June 30, 2024, the contract reimbursement ceiling is increased
18		from \$104,203.00 to \$106,285.00; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development Committee has reviewed Amendment No. 4
20		to the Arizona Department of Economic Security Planned Social Services Title XX
21		Block Grant Intergovernmental Agreement and recommend its approval.

23		accepts the Amendment No.4 to the Arizona Department of Economic Security
