## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Authorizing the Acquisition of the Do'ag Vecho (Darby Wells) Cemetery and Approving the Real Property Donation Agreement for the Donation, Transfer, Assignment, and Conveyance of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery from the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance to the Tohono O'odham Nation)

## RESOLUTION NO. 23-301

1	WHEREAS,	"[i]t shall be the policy of the Tohono O'odham Nation to seek the return to the
2		Tohono O'odham Nation of lands and natural resources, including minerals and
3	1	water rights, within or adjacent to the Tohono O'odham Nation, or which
4		originally were a part of the historic Papagueria" (Constitution of the Tohono
5		O'odham Nation, Article XVI, Section 9); and
6	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power "by law,
7		ordinance or resolution to purchase or otherwise acquire property" and to
8		"consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the
9		Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments on all
10		matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution,
11		Article VI, Section 1(i)(3) and Section 1(f)); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has identified sensitive lands available for
13		acquisition in western Pima County, Arizona near the Ajo community that were
14		originally part of the historic Papagueria, including the 20 acre Do'ag Vecho
15		(Darby Wells) Cemetery, which is privately owned and maintained by the Hia-Ced
16		O'odham Alliance, an Arizona nonprofit corporation; and
17	WHEREAS,	for generations, members of the Nation have buried their family members at the
18		Do'ag Vecho Cemetery and continue to return to the area to celebrate, gather, and
19		mourn with their families; and
20	WHEREAS,	by Resolution Nos. 96-138 and 96-270, the Legislative Council previously pursued
21		the acquisition of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery, and ultimately authorized the Hia-
22		Ced O'odham Alliance's acquisition of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery from the United
23		States; and
24	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 23-115, the Legislative Council supported the acquisition of the
25		Do'ag Vecho Cemetery, and established and authorized the Do'ag Vecho Recovery
26		Delegation to negotiate with the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance to acquire the Do'ag
27		Vecho Cemetery; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance seeks to donate the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery to the
29		Nation for acquisition into trust by the United States and inclusion within the
30		boundaries of the San Lucy District; and

WHEREAS, the ultimate objective of the acquisition of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery will be to have it held in trust by the United States for non-gaming purposes; and the Do'ag Vecho Recovery Delegation and the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance have prepared a Real Property Donation Agreement for the donation, transfer, assignment, and conveyance of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery from the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance to the Nation, and the Do'ag Vecho Recovery Delegation recommends its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the acquisition of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery by the Tohono O'odham Nation; provided that the Do'ag Vecho Recovery Delegation is directed to consult with the San Lucy District concerning inclusion of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery within the San Lucy District's boundaries when it is acquired in trust by the United States on behalf of the Nation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the Real Property Donation Agreement for the donation, transfer, assignment, and conveyance of the Do'ag Vecho Cemetery from the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance to the Tohono O'odham Nation and authorizes the Nation's chairperson to execute the Real Property Donation Agreement substantially in the same form attached hereto, provided that any amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, and to take all other actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>08<sup>TH</sup></u> day of <u>AUGUST 2023</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>3,218.0</u> FOR; <u>-0-AGAINST</u>; <u>-0-NOT VOTING</u>; and <u>[02] ABSENT</u>, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(b), Section 1(f), and Section 1(i)(3); and Article XVI, Section 9 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
