1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized to "consult, negotiate and
2		conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3		with Federal, State, and local governments on all matters within the authority
4		of the Tohono O'odham Council" and to "manage any funds within the exclusive
5		control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to appropriate these funds for the
6		benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these
7		funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution
8		or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)
9		and Section l(d)(2)); and
10	WHEREAS,	the banks of the Sells Wash are eroding and require stabilization; and
11	WHEREAS,	failure to stabilize the banks of the Sells Wash will result in damages to the Sells
12		Recreation Center and the infrastructure of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Sells Wash Bank Stabilization Project ("Project") is an ongoing project that
14		seeks to stabilize and manage erosion and storm water channeling in the Sells
15		Wash; and
16	WHEREAS,	in September 2008, the United States Department of Agriculture, Natural
17		Resources Conservation Services ("NRCS") approved initial design plans for the
18		Project; and
19	WHEREAS,	in September 2012, NRCS revised the design plans for the Project and approved
20		construction; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded an Emergency Watershed Protection
22		Program Grant ("EWP Program Grant") in the amount of \$264,810.75, of which
23		\$234,810.75 is designated for construction costs and \$30,000.00 is designated for
24		technical assistance costs, for the Project from the NRCS Emergency Watershed
25		Protection Program; and
26	WHEREAS,	the EWP Program Grant provides up to 75% federal share for construction cost
27		and requires a 25% tribal match for construction costs from the Nation in the
28		amount of \$78,270.25; and
29	WHEREAS,	an additional contribution from the Nation of \$42,000.00 for technical assistance
30		costs is required to complete the Project: and

the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2023-FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Sells Wash Bank Stabilization Project Budget, incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$385,081.00, of which \$120,270.25 shall be funded by the Nation's general fund surplus, and \$264,810.75 shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the United States Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Services, Emergency Watershed Protection Program; and

the Agricultural and Natural Resources, Commerce, Cultural Preservation, Human Resources Development, Water Resources, and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the EWP Program Grant and the FY 2023-FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Sells Wash Bank Stabilization Project Budget and recommend approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- accepts the United States Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources

- 2. approves the FY 2023-FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Sells Wash Bank Stabilization Project Budget, effective October 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023, in the amount of \$385,081.00, of which \$120,270.25 shall be funded by the Nation's general fund surplus and \$264,810.75 shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the United States Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Services, Emergency Watershed Protection Program.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and expend the FY 2023-FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Sells Wash Bank Stabilization Project Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
