9		Secretary of Veterans Affairs on all matters relating to Indian tribes, tribal
10	•	organizations, Native Hawaiian organizations, and Native American Veterans;

12	WHEREAS,	the Committee serves in an advisory capacity and makes recommendations to the
13		Secretary on ways the Department can improve the programs and services of the
14		Department to better serve Native American veterans; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Committee's membership will include individuals with diverse skills and
16		backgrounds, including at least one member from each of the 12 Indian Health
17		Service areas nominated by Indian tribes or tribal organizations; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development Committee recommends nominating
19		Representative Lucinda Allen for membership in the Advisory Committee on
20		Tribal and Indian Affairs for the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and
21		Representative DeLisa Ramon as alternate.
22	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council nominates
23		Representative Lucinda Allen for membership in the Advisory Committee on
24		Tribal and Indian Affairs for the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and
25		Representative DeLisa Ramon as alternate.
26	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that an appointment
27		made pursuant to this resolution shall immediately expire if the individual no
