

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2023-FY 2024 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-328**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval the**  
8 **FY 2023-FY 2024 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget,**  
9 **which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$24,000.00; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**  
11 **FY 2023-FY 2024 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget and**  
12 **recommend its approval.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
14 **FY 2023-FY 2024 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget**  
15 **effective August 1, 2023 through December 30, 2023 in the amount of \$24,000.00,**  
16 **which will be funded from the Nation's general fund.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Legislative**  
18 **Council chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
19 **expend the FY 2023-FY 2024 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project**  
20 **Budget, provided that any modifications shall be submitted to the Budget and**  
21 **Finance Committee for approval on behalf of the Legislative Council and any**  
22 **amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
23 **Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>**  
25 **day of SEPTEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**  
26 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
27 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
28 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
