	1	contracts that expend funds pursuant to appropriations or budgets authorized

11		Legislative Council, do not waive the Nation's sovereign immunity, do not
12		indemnify a third party or authorize payment of an award of attorney fees or cost,
13		and have undergone any required legal review; and
14	WHEREAS,	Legislative Order No. 06-047 further delegates to the Legislative Council
15	1	chairperson authority to "[a]llocate funds, staff, and other resources for the
16		effective operation of the Legislative Branch," "[a]pprove Legislative Branch
17		expenditures," and "[e]xercise general administrative control over Legislative
18		Branch offices, buildings, chambers and property;" and
19	WHEREAS,	by Legislative Order No. 16-039, the Legislative Council repealed the Revised
20		Legislative Branch Credit Card Policy and "direct[ed] the Legislative Council
21		chairperson to prepare and implement an updated credit card policy to govern
22		the use of credit cards issued to the Legislative Council officers and
23		administrative staff"; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Council chairperson adopted the updated Legislative Branch Credit Card
25		Policy, which became effective January 29, 2016; and
26	WHEREAS,	by Legislative Order No. 13-363, the Legislative Council approved the Legislative
27		Branch Travel Policy, which became effective September 18, 2013 and was
28		amended by Legislative Order No. 23-305 effective August 9, 2023; and
29	WHEREAS,	based on issues raised by the Rules and Budget and Finance Committees, the
30	1	Committees have conferred with the Legislative Council officers and recommend
31		supporting the officers' decision to engage an independent accounting firm to

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports an independent audit, under the Council officers' direction, of compliance with the Legislative Branch Credit Card Policy and other policies, including the Travel Policy. BE IT FURTHER ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that during the audit, the Legislative Council chairperson is directed to strictly implement the Legislative Branch's current policies, including the Credit Card Policy and Travel Policy, and to deny credit card use or travel requests by any Council representative or staff under investigation for violations of those Policies. BE IT FINALLY ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Legislative Council officers are directed to determine, based on available information, whether action is necessary to comply with the Standards of Conduct for Legislative Council Representatives and Alternates. The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the $06^{
m m}$ day of SEPTEMBER, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article V, Section 4 and Article VI, Section 1(a) and 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
