5		"Intergovernmental Agreement between Baboquivari Unified School District and

7		Instruction" and appropriated funds for Phase I of the Tohono O'odham Culture						
8	į	and Language Program ("Program") in the amount of \$261,787.50 to fund salaries						
9		and benefits for a culture and language director and two culture and language						
20	:	teachers during the BUSD 2021-2022 school year; and						
21	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 22-326, the Legislative Council approved the "Amended and						
22		Restated Intergovernmental Agreement between Baboquivari Unified School						
23		District and the Tohono O'odham Nation for the Joint Provision of Language and						
24		Culture Instruction" and appropriated funds for Year 1 of Phase II of the Program						
25		in the amount of \$278,386.62 for the BUSD 2022-2023 school year; and						
26	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 22-326, the Legislative Council further resolved that BUSD may						
27		request funding for the BUSD 2023-2024 school year, provided that any unused						
28		appropriated Nation's funds from the BUSD 2022-2023 school year be carried

1	WHEREAS, BUSD requests to proceed to Year 2 of Phase II of the Program with an
2	appropriation in the amount of \$274,364.50 from the Nation for the BUSD 2023-
3	2024 school year; and
4	WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development, Cultural Preservation, and Budget and
5	Finance Committees have reviewed the appropriation request from BUSD for
6	Year 2 of Phase II of the Program and recommend approval.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appropriates
8	\$274,364.50 from the Nation's general fund to the Baboquivari Unified School
9	District for Year 2 of Phase II of the Tohono O'odham Culture and Language
10	Program for the 2023-2024 school year with the express goal of language
11	revitalization, provided that the Baboquivari Unified School District will
12	continue to gather and present annual data of the ongoing progress of the Tohono
13	Oʻodham Culture and Language Program.
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Nation and
15	Baboquivari Unified School District agree to continue the "Amended and
16	Restated Intergovernmental Agreement between Baboquivari Unified School
17	District and the Tohono O'odham Nation for the Joint Provision of Language and
18	Culture Instruction" for the 2023-2024 school year, effective June 30, 2023.
19	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Baboquivar
20	Unified School District may request funding for the 2024-2025 school year
21	provided that any funds appropriated by the Legislative Council that remain
22	unused at the end of any school year shall be carried over and applied to the
23	Nation's obligation for the following school year.
