## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Designating Tohono O'odham Nation's Arizona Indian Gaming Association and Arizonans for Tribal Government Gaming Representatives and Alternates)

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-344** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on
3		behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments
4		and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions,
5		or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the
6		Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Nation and the State of Arizona have entered into a tribal-state gaming
8		compact (the "Compact") for the conduct of Class III gaming on the Nation's
9		Indian lands; and
10	WHEREAS,	consistent with the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2701 et seq., the
11		Compact recognizes "gaming by Indian tribes as a means of promoting tribal
12	5	economic development, self-sufficiency, and strong tribal governments"
13		(Compact, Declaration of Policy and Purpose); and
14	WHEREAS,	the Arizona Indian Gaming Association ("AIGA") is an association of eight
15		sovereign tribal governments in Arizona, including the Nation, and is organized
16		in part to "preserve and protect the integrity and exclusivity of tribal gaming" and
17		to "maintain, protect, and advocate for Indian tribal sovereignty" (2017 AIGA
18		Amended and Restated Bylaws, Article 1, Sections 1.3(F) and (G); and
19	WHEREAS,	the Arizonaus for Tribal Government Gaming ("ATGG") is organized as a joint
20		effort of sovereign tribal governments located in Arizona with a purpose of
21		protecting and promoting Indian tribes in Arizona by supporting tribal
22		government gaming on Arizona's Indian lands (2017 ATGG Amended and Restated
23		Bylaws, Article 1, Section 1.3); and
24	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's interests to continue its active participation in the AIGA and
25		ATGG; and
26	WHEREAS,	consistent with Nation's long-standing practice, the Commerce Committee
27	i	recommends designating the Nation's chairperson as the Designated
28		Representative and the Commerce Committee chairperson as Alternate
29		Representative on the AIGA and ATGG (Resolutions No. 95-522 and No. 10-224);

Article 2, Section 2.3 of the Amended and Restated Bylaws of AIGA.

2. Designates Chairman Verlon M. Jose as the Nation's Designated Representative to the Arizonaus for Tribal Government Gaming and Commerce Committee Chairwoman Victoria Hobbs as the Nation's Alternate Representative in the absence of the Nation's chairperson, as defined by Article 2, Section 2.3 of the Amended and Restated Bylaws of ATGG.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the current officeholders designated by this resolution shall automatically be replaced by their respective successors in office as Nation's chairperson and Commerce Committee chairperson,

m TH}$ day of SEPTEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR: -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
