

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting  
Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-347**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community  
8 Service Grant Unrestricted Budget in the amount of \$230,258.41 was approved by  
9 Resolution No. 22-271; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Hewel Ni'ok has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2023  
11 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference and which will  
12 adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community  
14 Service Grant Unrestricted Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the FY 2023  
15 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community Service  
16 Grant Unrestricted Budget by \$32,398.79 from \$230,258.41 to \$262,657.20; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the  
18 FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community  
19 Service Grant Unrestricted Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its  
20 approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
22 FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community  
23 Service Grant Unrestricted Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2022,  
24 which increases the FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public  
25 Broadcasting Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget by \$32,398.79 from  
26 \$230,258.41 to \$262,657.20 that shall be funded by FY2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN CPB  
27 CSG final allocation and FY2022 carry forward funds.

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
29 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
30 expend the FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting  
31 Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget as amended, provided that any
