13	WHEREAS,	fees for services provided under this Contract will be paid out of the FY 2024
14		Advocate Program Budget in accordance with the terms of the FY 2024
15		Professional Services Contract with Douglas Tyler Francis, Esq., for the period of
16		October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2024; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the contract and recommends
18	1	approval by Legislative Council.
