

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Isabel Amsel, Esq.)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-353

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power to “employ legal counsel for the protection and advancement of the**
3 **rights of the Tohono O'odham Nation” (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
4 **Nation, Article VI, Section 2(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the increasing needs of tribal members for legal representation in criminal and**
6 **juvenile offender matters has caused a need for attorneys to handle cases where**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Advocate Program is ethically conflicted out of the**
8 **representation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Advocate Program has prepared and submitted for review**
10 **and approval FY 2024 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono**
11 **O'odham Nation and Isabel Amsel Esq, to represent clients who cannot be**
12 **represented by the Nation's Advocate Program due to a conflict of interest; and**

13 **WHEREAS, fees for services provided under this Contract will be paid out of the FY 2024**
14 **Advocate Program Budget in accordance with the terms of the FY 2024**
15 **Professional Services Contract with Isabel Amsel, Esq., for the period of October**
16 **1, 2023 to September 30, 2024; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the contract and recommends**
18 **approval by the Legislative Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2024 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and**
21 **Isabel Amsel, Esq., in substantially the form attached.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Nation's**
23 **chairperson to execute the Professional Services Contract with Isabel Amsel, Esq.,**
24 **provided that any amendments to the Professional Services Contract shall be**
25 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH**
27 **day of SEPTEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**
28 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
