1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to appoint
2		judges to the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court pursuant to the Constitution of the
3		Tohono O'odham Nation, which states, "[t]he Tohono O'odham Courts shall be
4		courts of record and shall consist of at least six (6) judges appointed by the Tohono
5		O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VIII, Section 3); and
6	WHEREAS,	the Constitution requires the judges' terms to be staggered so that approximately
7		one-third of the judges are appointed every other year (Constitution, Article VIII,
8		Section 4); and
9	WHEREAS,	6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1 provides in part that "a candidate for Judicial
10		Court judge who possesses a juris doctorate shall be licensed to practice in any
11		state, be a member in good standing with a state bar association, and have at least
12		three years of experience as a practicing attorney" (Section 1103(C)(3)(a)); and
13	WHEREAS,	6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1 further provides that "[t]rial court judges shall
14		serve six-year terms, provided that an appointment to fill a vacancy occurring
15		before the expiration of a term shall be made only for the remaining balance of
16		that term" (Section 1103(A)); and
17	WHEREAS,	candidate Debra S. Doll has applied for appointment to the Tohono O'odham
18		Judicial Court, possesses a juris doctorate, is licensed to practice law in New
19		Mexico, is a member in good standing with the State Bar of New Mexico, and has
20		at least three years of experience as a practicing attorney; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Judiciary Committee, having legislative oversight of matters pertaining to the
22		Tohono O'odham Judicial Court, has reviewed Debra S. Doll's application and
23		background information, and has interviewed Debra S. Doll; and
24	WHEREAS,	there are currently two vacancies on the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court with
25		terms expiring January 31, 2029; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has likewise interviewed candidate Debra S. Doll and
27		reviewed her application materials and background investigation report.
28	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it appoints
29		Debra S. Doll as a Tohono O'odham Judicial Court judge for a term beginning the
30		effective date of this resolution and ending January 31, 2029, provided that she
31		shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until a successor is appointed
32		and sworn in if she satisfies the requirements of 6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter
33		1, Section 1103 (C)(2) and (3).
