

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2024 Gu-Vo District Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-371**

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
2 Nation,

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**  
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**  
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by**  
6 **a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has**  
7 **furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono**  
8 **O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks**  
9 **signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or**  
10 **vice chairman of the district council.**

11 **; and**

12 **WHEREAS,** by Gu-Vo District Council Resolution No. GV-23-075, the Gu-Vo District has  
13 **authorized the FY 2024 Gu-Vo District Budget, which is incorporated by this**  
14 **reference, in the amount of \$5,529,425.24; and**

15 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2024 Gu-Vo District  
16 **Budget and recommends its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
18 **FY 2024 Gu-Vo District Budget effective October 1, 2023 in the amount of**  
19 **\$5,529,425.24, which shall be funded as follows:**

- 20 **1. August 2023 District Gaming Allocation in the amount of \$5,373,205.73;**
- 21 **2. FY 2015 Ali Chugk Community carryover funds in the amount of**  
22 **\$54,966.02;**
- 23 **3. FY 2016 Ali Chugk Community carryover funds in the amount of**  
24 **\$56,464.29; and**
- 25 **4. FY 2017 Ali Chugk Community carryover funds in the amount of**  
26 **\$44,789.20.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2024 Gu- Vo  
28 **District Budget shall be managed and expended in accordance with Article IX,**  
29 **Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws,**  
30 **provided that any amendments or modifications shall be authorized under**  
31 **District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by the Tohono**  
32 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19<sup>TH</sup> day of SEPTEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
