10		disparities in American Indian and Alaska Native populations; and
11	WHEREAS,	the CIIHE Tribal Advisory Committee consists of 16 delegate positions, one from
12		each of the 12 geographic areas served by the Indian Health Service and four
13		national at-large member positions; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee recommends nominating
15		Representative Vivian Juan Saunders as the primary delegate to the Office of
16		Minority Health Center for Indigenous Innovation and Health Equity Tribal
17		Advisory Committee and Representative Leander V. Mase as alternate.
