

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting a No Cost Extension for the FY 2024 Department of Health and
Human Services Tribal Opioid Response Grant Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-399

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d) (2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation received notice of award from the U.S. Department**
8 **of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services**
9 **Administration ("SAMHSA") for the Tribal Opioid Response Grant Program for a**
10 **no-cost extension in the amount of \$855,000.00 to utilize carry forward funds for**
11 **period September 30, 2023 through September 29, 2024; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for**
13 **review and approval its FY 2024 Division of Behavioral Health Tribal Opioid**
14 **Response Grant Budget in the amount of \$855,000.00, which shall be funded by**
15 **the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the**
16 **Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health**
17 **Services Administration; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services FY 2024 Division of Behavioral**
19 **Health Tribal Opioid Response Grant Budget personnel expenses shall be**
20 **retroactive to September 30, 2023; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have**
22 **reviewed the FY 2024 Department of Health and Human Services Tribal Opioid**
23 **Response Grant Budget and recommend its approval.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
25 **FY 2024 Department of Health and Human Services Tribal Opioid Response Grant**
26 **Budget effective September 30, 2023, through September 29, 2024, in the amount**
27 **of \$855,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending**
28 **reimbursement from the grantor, the Department of Health and Human Services**
29 **Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.**

30 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
31 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
32 **expend the FY 2024 Department of Health and Human Services Tribal Opioid**

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Response Grant Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of OCTOBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section I(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
