1	WHEREAS,	on June 28, 1997, the Nation's voters approved Initiative No. IN-01-97, the
2		"O'odham Voice on Use of Gaming Revenues" (the "Initiative"), which authorizes
3		per capita payments to the Nation's members provided that sufficient gaming
4		revenues are available; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Ordinance for the Regulation of Gaming Activities Within the Tohono
6		O'odham Nation (the "Gaming Ordinance") was subsequently amended to
7		authorize per capita distribution payments in accordance with the Initiative
8		(Legislative Council Resolution No. 97-303); and
9	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution No. 97-451 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
10		adopted an Initiative Funding and Implementation Plan; and
11	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council did adopt the Revenue Allocation Plan pursuant to
12		Legislative Council Resolution No. 97-452; and
13	WHEREAS,	by letter dated December 18, 1997, the Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs
14		approved the Initial Per Capita Distribution; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Enrollment Office submitted to the Tohono O'odham
16		Legislative Council the Certification of Eligible Members for the Initial Per Capita
17		Distribution for review and approval; and
18	WHEREAS,	Legislative Council approved the Certification of Eligible Members, with the
19		initial number of 11,233 verified adult members (Resolution Number 97-525); and
20	WHEREAS,	the disbursement of funds to each eligible adult member is contingent upon
21		verification of a member and certification by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
22		Council; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Department of Membership Services has submitted a
24		certification listing of one verified adult member who is listed on the previously
25		approved Certification of Eligible Members and is eligible to receive the initial
26		per capita payment.
27	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:
28		1. Approves the verification and certification of the adult member listed on the
29		attached November 2023 Certification Listing of An Adult Member for the
30		Initial Per Capita Distribution.
31		2. Approves the distribution for \$2,000, less any applicable taxes required by
32		federal law, to the adult member listed.

3. Authorizes the Chairperson of the Nation or a designated official to execute such other documents as may be necessary to implement this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the disbursement of funds to additional eligible Tohono O'odham adult members is contingent upon verification of membership by the Tohono O'odham Department of Membership Services and certification by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>06TM</u> day of <u>NOVEMBER 2023</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>3,263.3</u> FOR; <u>-0- AGAINST</u>; <u>-0- NOT VOTING</u>; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
