9		impact upon Congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service has provided a Tribal Priority ranking of the four most
11		critical projects and allocated points, which impacts the overall prioritization of
12	i	projects; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided the
14		recommendations to the Health and Human Services Committee regarding the
15		most critical needs; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and recommends
17		approval of the four most critical and desirable priorities.
