

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-429

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2024 Office of Attorney General's original budget in the amount of**
8 **\$3,719,287.76 was approved by Resolution No. 23-192; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Office of Attorney General has prepared and submitted for review and**
10 **approval its FY 2024 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**
11 **reference, and which will adjust operational line items including a one-time**
12 **increase for the Professional Services line item; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2024 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the**
14 **FY 24 Office of Attorney General Budget by \$478,000.00, from \$3,719,287.76 to**
15 **\$4,197,287.76; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget and Finance Committee have**
17 **reviewed the FY 2024 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 and**
18 **recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2024 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1, which includes a**
21 **\$478,000.00 increase, from \$3,719,287.76 to \$4,197,287.76, that shall be funded by**
22 **the Nation's general fund.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
25 **expend the FY 2024 Office of Attorney General Budget as amended, provided that**
26 **any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**
27 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH**
29 **day of NOVEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,042.8 FOR;**
30 **220.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
31 **by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
32 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
33 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
34 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
