## **RESOLUTION NO. 23-441**

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized to "consult, negotiate and
2		conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation"
3		and "to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham
4		Nation and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its
5		members" provided that "(a)ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to
6		appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution
7		of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f) and Section 1(d)(2); and
8	WHEREAS,	the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Pasture, Rangeland, Forage
9		Pilot Insurance Program ("PRF" Insurance Program") is designated to provide
10		insurance coverage on pasture, rangeland, or forage acres using rainfall index to
11		determine precipitation for coverage purposes, instead of measuring production
12		or loss of productions themselves (USDA Pasture, Rangeland, Forage Pilot
13	<u>.</u>	Insurance Program Fact Sheet, available at https://www.rma.usda.gov/en/Fact-
14		Sheets/National-Fact-Sheets/Pasture-Rangeland-Forage-Pilot-Insurance-
15		Program); and
16	WHERES,	coverage is "based on a producer's selection of coverage level, index intervals,
17	,	and productivity factor" and insurance payments are determined by using
18	ž	National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Climate Prediction Center
19		("NOAA CPC") data, which uses a grid system to determine precipitation amounts
20		within an area, for grids and index intervals that the producer chose to insure
21		(USDA Pasture, Rangeland, Forage Pilot Insurance Program Fact Sheet); and
22	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 17-570, Resolution No. 18-397 and Resolution No. 19-430, No 22-
23		408, the Legislative Council authorized the submission of the Nation's PRF
24		Insurance Policy Application for crop years 2018, FY 2019 2020, 2023 and
25		approved accompanying FY 2018, FY 2019 FY 2020, and 2023 Department of
26		Natural Resources USDA PRF Insurance Program Budgets; and
27	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 18-264, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted the
28		Tohono O'odham Nation Range and Agriculture Fund Management Plan
29		(thereafter, "Plan"); and
30	WHEREAS,	pursuant to B.3. of the Plan, "[s]subject to prior approval by Council and provide
31		there are sufficient funds in the Fund to cover the annual premium payment, the

- WHEREAS. in accordance with the Plan, the Nation's Treasurer has confirmed that there are sufficient funds to cover the \$4,446,567.00 premium payment for crop year 2024 if indemnity payments do not exceed the premium payment; and
- WHEREAS, the Nation's Chairman, Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the PRF application for crop year 2024 and FY 2024 Department of Natural Resources USDA PRF Insurance Program Budget and the Chairman and Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee recommend approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- authorizes submission of the PRF Insurance Policy Application for the 1) Nation's participation in the USDA's Pasture, Rangeland, Forage insurance Program for crop year 2024 through its insurance agent CKP Insurance:
- Approves the FY 2024 Department of Natural Resources USDA PRF 2) Insurance Program Budget, effective October 1, 2023 in the amount of \$4,446,567.00 that shall be funded by the Tohono O'odham Nation Range and Agriculture Fund and indemnity revenue; and;
- 3) Grants permission for the United States Department of Agriculture, or its representative, to audit and inspect the areas insured, provided they give the Nation's Department of Natural Resources executive director five business days advanced written notice and are accompanied by a designated Nation's employee or official.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Nation's Chairman to execute, sign, and deliver all related documents, agreements, contracts, for participation in the USDA Pasture, Rangeland, Forage Insurance Program.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the  $30^{\mathrm{TH}}$ day of NOVEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,720.7 FOR; 542.6 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) and Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
