RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving the First Things First Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation Regional Partnership Council, Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Board, and the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-454

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the power to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on
3		behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments
4		and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions,
5		or with private person or organizations on all matters within the authority of the
6		Tohono O'odham Council." (Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes and prioritizes the importance of health,
8		education, and general wellbeing of its children; and
9	WHEREAS,	in 2006, Arizona voters passed proposition 203 to create the First Things First
10		Initiative, which increases the quality and accessibility of early childhood
11		programs that help ensure that all Arizona children enter school healthy and
12		ready to learn; and
13	WHEREAS,	the First Things First Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA"), incorporated by this
14		reference, provides the Tohono O'odham Nation with funding, updates the
15		Standards of Practice, and renews the term of agreement from July 1, 2023
16		through June 30, 2024, with the option to renew this Agreement for up to three (3)
17		additional twelve (12) month extensions; and
18	WHEREAS,	as written, the IGA states that the Nation "agree[s] to use arbitration to resolve [a]
19		dispute to the extent required under Arizona Revised Statute § 12-1518 and not
20		otherwise prohibited by law," but that this provision does not require the Nation
21		to litigate in Arizona Superior Courts; and
22	WHEREAS,	since the arbitration provision does not require litigation in Arizona Superior
23		Courts, the Nation does not explicitly waive its sovereign immunity under the IGA;
24		and
25	WHEREAS,	Legislative Council is nonetheless aware that by entering the IGA, the Nation
26		subjects itself to Arizona law and that a federal court or other jurisdiction may
27		find that the arbitration provision contains an implicit waiver of sovereign
28		immunity; and
29	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the First Things First
30		IGA and recommends its approval.

5	O'odham Nation Chairperson to execute it in substantially the form attached,
6	provided that any amendment to the IGA be submitted to the Legislative Council
7	for prior approval.
