LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 23-461

1	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is vested with the power to "establish rules and
2		procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3		committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4		O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council
6		with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative
7		Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and
8	WHEREAS,	Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
9		Council, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at the
10		Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O'odham
11		Nation, with the following exceptions [a] majority of all the legislative
12		representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than the
13		chambers located at Sells."; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Appropriations Committee has requested a special session on January 10,
15		2024 for the Legislative Council to attend the Arizona State Legislature Indian
16		Nations and Tribes Legislative Day.
17	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a
18		special session on January 10, 2024 for the Legislative Council to attend the
19		Arizona State Legislature Indian Nations and Tribes Legislative Day with roll call
20		beginning at [TIME] at the Arizona State Legislature.
