		the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham
1	WHEREAS,	Legislative Council with the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public
2		health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham
3		Nation and its members," "to provide for removal or exclusion from the Tohono
4		O'odham Nation of non-members whose presence may be injurious to the peace,
5		
6		health or welfare of the Tohono O'odham," and "to preserve and cultivate native
7		arts, crafts and traditions" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2), (c)(7), and
8		(c)(8));
9	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 13-165, the Legislative Council enacted the Research Code of the
10		Tohono O'odham Nation, which establishes the Nation's Institutional Review
11		Board ("IRB") as an independent entity consisting of five Nation's enrolled
12		members with relevant experience and expertise to review and consider whether
13		a proposed research proposal should be granted, denied, withheld, or approved
14		on a modified basis (17 T.O.C. Chapter 8); and
15	WHEREAS,	under the Research Code's enforcement provisions, "[n]o research shall be
16		performed within the jurisdiction of the Nation or otherwise subject to [the
17		Research Code] unless the researcher has first received review, approval, and a
18		permit from the Nation's IRB" (17 T.O.C. Chapter 8, Section 81010(A)); and
19	WHEREAS,	Research Code Section 81010(B) further provides, "Any outside agency or
20		researcher conducting research within the jurisdiction of the Nation without a
21		permit or otherwise in violation of this Chapter shall be subject to exclusion from
22		the Nation in accordance with the Nation's laws governing removal and
23		exclusion."; and
24	WHEREAS,	an exhibit titled "Cause and Effect: That's What you Get!" / "They Don't Love You
25		Like I Love You: Indigenous Perspectives on Sovereignty" is scheduled to open at
26		the Tohono O'odham Cultural Center and Museum on Friday, December 8, 2023;

28	WHEREAS,	the Nation's IRB gathered preliminary evidence demonstrating that the
29		individuals and organizations responsible for the exhibit may have violated the
30		Nation's Research Code by not first obtaining a research permit before
31	:	conducting research on the Nation's lands and interviewing Nation's members
32		and elders (Research Code Sections 8103, 8106, and 8107); and

Museum to Suspend the Display of Exhibit, "Cause and Effect: That's What you Get!" / "They Don't Love You Like I Love You: Indigenous Perspectives on Sovereignty") Page 2 of 2 the Nation's IRB needs additional time to make an official determination; and WHEREAS, 1 the Human Resources Development and Cultural Preservation Committees 2 WHEREAS. recommend strongly urging the Nation's chairperson to instruct the Cultural 3 Center and Museum to suspend the display of the exhibit until the Nation's IRB 4 can make an official determination as to whether a violation of the Research Code 5 occurred. 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council strongly urges 7 the Nation's chairperson to instruct the Tohono O'odham Cultural Center and 8 Museum to suspend the display of the exhibit, "Cause and Effect: That's What you 9 Get!" / "They Don't Love You Like I Love You: Indigenous Perspectives on 10 Sovereignty," until the Nation's Institutional Review Board can make an official 11 determination as to whether the individuals and organizations responsible for 12 the exhibit violated the Nation's Research Code. 13 BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council strongly urges the 14 suspension of any further publication, reproduction, dissemination, or display of 15 the exhibit materials until the Nation's Institutional Review Board can make an 16 official determination. 17 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the  ${
