

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Enrollment Resolution Nos. 245-84, 365-85, 93-003, 98-429, 06-511,
13-109, and 16-448 to Reflect Legal Name Changes of Enrolled Members**

RESOLUTION NO. 24-071

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to enact laws
2 and ordinances governing the enrollment and adoption of members (Constitution
3 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article II, Sections 1 and 2 and Article VI, Section
4 1(h)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Articles VI and VII of the Nation's Enrollment Ordinance, the
6 Enrollment Committee shall review membership applications and make a written
7 recommendation to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to approve or reject
8 the application (14 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1 - Enrollment Ordinance);
9 and

10 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article VIII of the Nation's Enrollment Ordinance, the Tohono
11 O'odham Legislative Council shall determine eligibility for membership or
12 adoption; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Enrollment Program has received official documents reflecting the legal name
14 changes of enrolled members as a result of marriage, divorce, legal adoption, or
15 for other reasons; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Enrollment Committee recommends that Resolution Nos. 245-84, 365-85, 93-
17 003, 98-429, 06-511, 13-109, and 16-448 be amended to reflect the legal name
18 changes of members identified in the March 2024 Legal Enrollment Resolution
19 Summary, which is incorporated by this reference.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
21 that Resolution Nos. 245-84, 365-85, 93-003, 98-429, 06-511, 13-109, and 16-
22 448 are amended upon the effective date of those resolutions to reflect the legal
23 name changes of members identified in the March 2024 Legal Enrollment
24 Resolution Summary.

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH**
26 **day of MARCH 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**
27 **~~-0-~~ AGAINST; ~~-0-~~ NOT VOTING; and ~~-0-~~ ABSENT,** pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
28 **by Article II, Sections 1 and 2 and Article VI, Section 1(h) of the Constitution of the Tohono**
29 **O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved**
30 **by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**
31 **pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
