

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads  
Program San Lucy Sidewalks & Street Lights Budget Amendment No. 2)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-076**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
8 San Lucy Sidewalks & Street Lights Budget Amendment #1 in the amount of  
9 \$117,174.68 was approved by Resolution No. 22-423; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program has  
11 prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2024 San Lucy Sidewalks  
12 & Street Lights Budget Amendment No.2, which is incorporated by this reference  
13 and which will add construction line item; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program will  
15 increase the FY2024 San Lucy Sidewalks & Street Lights Budget by \$182,825.32  
16 from \$117,174.68 to \$300,000.00; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have  
18 reviewed the FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads  
19 Program San Lucy Sidewalks & Street Lights Budget Amendment No. 2 and  
20 recommend its approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves  
22 the FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
23 San Lucy Sidewalks & Street Lights Budget Amendment No. 2 effective October 1,  
24 2023 to September 30, 2025, which includes a \$182,825.32 increase from  
25 \$117,174.68 to \$300,000.00 total that shall be funded by the Nation's general  
26 fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono  
28 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer  
29 and expend the FY 2024 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads  
30 Program San Lucy Sidewalks & Street Lights Budget Amendment No. 2 as  
31 amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for  
32 prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
