## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Adopting Nation's Investment Committee Plan of Operation)

RESOLUTION NO. 24-108

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "provide for,			
2		appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers			
3		of committees, boards, officers and agents provided that no such committee,			
4		board, officer, agent or organization shall exercise powers of the Tohono			
5		O'odham Council unless they are expressly delegated by the Tohono O'odham			
6		Council." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(b));			
7		and			
8	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Constitution also vests the Legislative Council with fiscal powers,			
9		including "to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono			
10		O'odham Nation, including proceeds derived from lands and resources of the			
11		Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,			
12		Section 1(d)(2)); and			
13	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Investment Committee, which is currently comprised of the Budget			
14		and Finance Committee, the Nation's chairperson, and the Nation's treasurer,			
15		was established by Resolution No. 91-042 to manage and oversee the financial			
16		investments of the Nation's funds, including funds held and managed by the			
17		federal government on the Nation's behalf; and			
18	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Investment Committee has drafted and recommends adoption of the			
19		Nation's Investment Committee Plan of Operation, which is incorporated by this			
20		reference, to govern the Committee's powers, membership, voting, and meetings;			
21		and			
22	WHEREAS,	the Rules Committee has reviewed and recommends adoption of the Investment			
23		Committee Plan of Operation.			
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts the				
25		Nation's Investment Committee Plan of Operation, which shall supersede and			
26		replace any inconsistent or conflicting delegations of authority and resolutions.
