9		support from the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
10	WHEREAS,	of the Áshiihí (Salt People), born for Ta'neeszahnii (Tangle clan), his grandfather's
11		clan is Tódích'íi'nii (Bitter Water Clan) and paternal grandfather's clan is
12		Táchii'nii (Red-Running-Into-The-Water Clan), former President Nez grew up in
1.3		a rural, low-income home in Shonto, Arizona, in the Navajo Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	former President Nez has a long, distinguished career in public service,
15		beginning with his election to the office of Vice President of the Shonto Chapter,
16		the Navajo Nation Council, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors, and his
17		election to the office of Vice President of the Navajo Nation in 2015; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Appropriations Committee met with former President Nez, discussed a
19		number of important issues, and recommends endorsing his candidacy for
20		Arizona's Second Congressional District.
21	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council endorses
22		Jonathan Nez's candidacy for Arizona's Second Congressional District; provided
23		that Nation's members are encouraged to vote as they deem appropriate.
