

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1 and Contract Agreement)

RESOLUTION NO. 24-137

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office Equal**
8 **Employment Opportunity Commission Budget in the amount of \$30,000.00 was**
9 **approved by Resolution No. 23-178; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
11 **approval its FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
12 **Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1, which is**
13 **incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or**
14 **personnel line items; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office Equal**
16 **Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the**
17 **FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office Equal**
18 **Employment Opportunity Commission Budget by \$2,000.00 from \$30,000.00 to**
19 **\$32,000.00; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office Equal**
21 **Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1 includes a**
22 **Contract Agreement between the Nation and the Equal Employment Opportunity**
23 **Commission, which is incorporated by this reference; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
25 **reviewed the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights**
26 **Office Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1 and**
27 **Contract Agreement and recommend its approval.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:**

- 29 **1. the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
30 **Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1**
31 **effective October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024, which includes a**
32 **\$2,000.00 increase from \$30,000.00 to \$32,000.00 that shall be funded by the**


1 Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the Equal Employment
2 Opportunity Commission; and

3 2. the Contract Agreement between the Nation and the Equal Employment
4 Opportunity Commission.

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
7 expend the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office
8 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget, provided that any
9 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
10 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH
12 day of MAY 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0-
13 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
14 Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)and(3)and1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
15 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
16 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
17 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
