

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting July 17, 2024 Special Session for Roads Program Presentation by the Planning and Economic Development Department and Bureau of Indian Affairs)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 24-206

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vest the Council
6 with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative
7 Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and


8 **WHEREAS,** Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
9 Council provides that "All Legislative Council sessions shall be held at the Tohono
10 O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O'odham Nation,
11 with the following exceptions . . . [a] majority of all the legislative representatives
12 may vote to hold a session in some location other than the chambers located at
13 Sells."; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Appropriations Committees are
15 requesting a special session be set on July 17, 2024 for a Roads Program
16 presentation by the Planning and Economic Development Department and
17 Bureau of Indian Affairs.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a
19 special session on July 17, 2024, to be held at Hanum Kuk gym location for a Roads
20 Program presentation by the Planning and Economic Development Department
21 and Bureau of Indian Affairs.

22 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of
23 JULY, 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,027.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
24 -0- NOT VOTING; and 236.2[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
25 VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
26 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
28 (48 Stat.984).
