

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2024-FY 2026 Judicial Branch New Probation Building  
Budget Amendment No. 3)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-232**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2021 Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget in the amount of**  
8 **\$2,042,909.86 was approved by Resolution No. 20-379 and subsequently amended**  
9 **by Resolution No. 21-465 as FY 2022 Judicial Branch New Probation Building**  
10 **Budget and Resolution No. 22-329 as FY 2022-2024 Judicial Branch New Probation**  
11 **Building Budget; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the funding period for the FY 2022-2024 Judicial Branch New Probation Building**  
13 **Budget is scheduled to end on September 30, 2024; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch is requesting to extend the budget for FY 2022-2024 Judicial**  
15 **Branch New Probation Building Budget to September 30, 2026; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the FY 2024-FY 2026 Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget Amendment**  
17 **No. 3 will not change the budget amount of \$2,042,909.86; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2024 FY**  
19 **2026 Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget Amendment No. 3 to extend**  
20 **budget period and recommend its approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
22 **FY 2024-FY 2026 Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget Amendment No.**  
23 **3 in the amount of \$2,042,909.86, to extend the budget period to September 30,**  
24 **2026.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the chief judge and**  
26 **any designated official is authorized to expend and administer the FY 2024-FY**  
27 **2026 Judicial Branch New Probation Building Budget as amended, provided that**  
28 **any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**  
29 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup> day of AUGUST 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section (d)(2) the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
